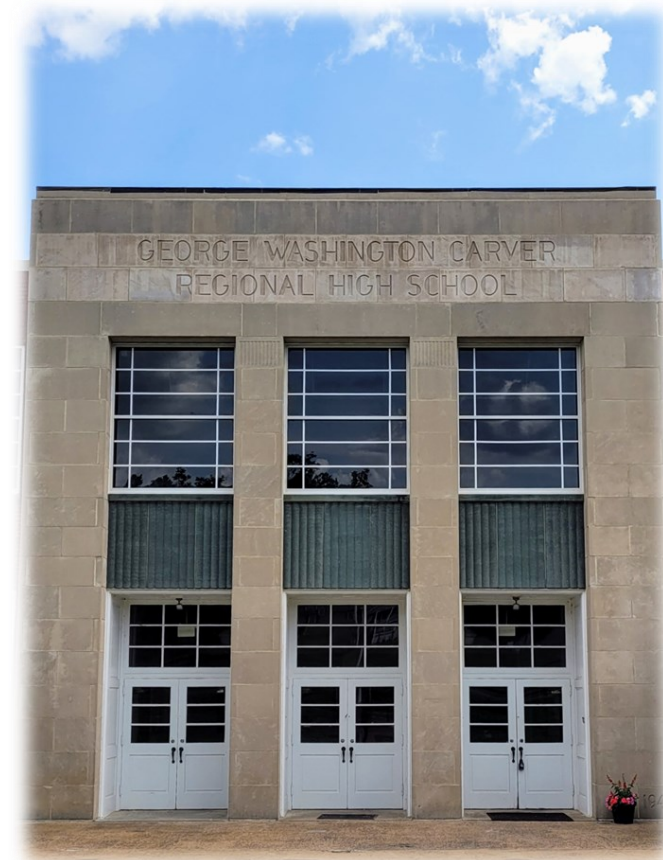

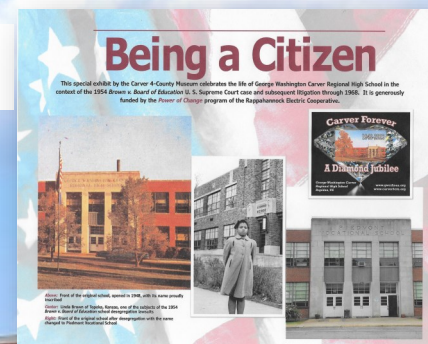

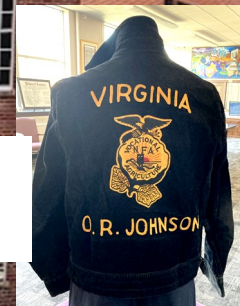


Mural by J. Hubert Jackson, *GWCRHS* class of '61
